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Museum of Justice wears a new look

Hon'ble Governor of Odisha Prof. Ganeshi Lal inaugurated the stunning Museum of Justice on February 25, 2023. The Museum was revamped and renovated to preserve the heritage and history of the Judiciary in Odisha.

The beautification and development of the 3-acre land was taken up by CMC. The pond in the premises was desilted, cleaned and a beautiful fountain installed. Colourful footpaths were created and the lawn was adorned with ornate sculptures. The existing boundary was reconstructed along with the paver approach road to the museum and an adventure park created for the children. EWS Housing, Naranpur

To cater to the Economically Weaker Section (EWS), Cuttack Development Authority (CDA) has developed an affordable housing project at Naranpur. It offers 1BHK flats along with supporting amenities. A total of 550 EWS units are being constructed in seventeen G+3 storeyed blocks. The total built up area of each flat is 346.6 sqft. The site is located on a 40 feet wide road connected to the 100ft wide Trisulia-Gopalpur main road. The project which started on Sept 29, 2020 is almost complete and the allotment of flats will start soon.

- Biometric attendance for all Swachha Karmis, Drivers, Loaders, working at MCC and MRF. Apart from that, biometric attendance for all CMC staff working at Biju Bhawan, Bikash Bhawan and other offices.
- Non-recyclable dry waste processed through MRF to be sent to cement manufacturing units as directed by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Development, GoO. In case of deviance, fine will be imposed as directed by National Green Tribunal. CMC will bear the cost of vehicle rent for transportation.

Special Council Meeting

March 2, 2023

The draft budget amounting to Rs 587,56,57,000.00 (Five hundred eighty-seven crores, fifty-six lakhs and fifty-seven thousand) was prepared by CMC and sent to the Finance Standing Committee for recommendation. It was presented at the Special Council Meeting for suggestion. It was decided to increase the revenue of CMC and actions will be taken for the same.

11th Council Meeting

March 9, 2023

The annual budget amounting to Rs.602,72,73,000.00 (Six hundred two crores, seventy-two lakhs and seventy-three thousand) was finalized at the 11th Council Meeting held at Biju Bhawan the budget was unanimously accepted and sent to the Government for approval. The meeting was presided by Mayor Shri Subhash Chandra Singh and attended by Deputy Mayor, CMC Commissioner, Finance Officer, Corporators and concerned Officers.



Vaccination Program

CMC conducted a 10-day drug administration program from February 10 to 19, 2023 to protect citizens from filariasis and intestinal worms. It covered more than five lakh beneficiaries.

The program commenced with the City-level inauguration of Mass Drug Administration (MDA) and National Deworming Day (NDD), held at Urban Community Health Centre (UCHC), CDA on Feb 10. It was inaugurated by Mayor Shri Subhash Chandra Singh, in presence of CMC Commissioner, City Health Officer, City Programme Management Unit (NUHM) and other concerned officials. On the occasion, an awareness vehicle for sensitizing people on the program was also inaugurated.

Earlier a City Coordination Committee meeting was held on January 25, chaired by Mayor to chart out a plan for the program. Several capacity building workshops were conducted at various UCHCs and UPHCs across the city, to orient the drug providers, for successful implementation of the program.

Circle and Median near Bellevue square of Kathajodi river of Ring Road side near Judicial Academy. A 66-bedded Working Women's hostel (Bhagat Hostel) will soon come up at Buxi Bazar Cuttack at an estimated cost of Rs.3.99 crore by OSIC Ltd.

The Silver City paid rich tribute to Utkala Gaurav Madhusudhan Das on his death anniversary on January 4, 2023 by laying the foundation stone for several developmental and beautification projects by CMC at an estimated cost of around Rs 13.64 crores.

The foundation stone for the beautification of Madhusudan Das Samadhi Pitha was laid by Mayor at Gorakbar. The project, built at an estimated cost of Rs.75.30 lacs includes construction of boundary wall, installation of water fountain, landscaping, provision of drinking water and advanced lighting facility. The work will be carried out in two phases in consultation with the Christian community and executed by OSIC Ltd.

To commemorate the occasion, Mayor Shri Subash Chandra Singh inaugurated a 'Mo Khatta' selling counter near Madhukunja Park, in presence of Deputy Mayor Damayanti Majhi, CMC Commissioner Shri Nikhil Pavan Kalyan, Collector and District Magistrate Shri Bhawani Shankar Chayani, Editor, Sambad, Shri Soumya Ranjan Patnaik, Social Activist Dr.Rabiranjan Sahu, Corporators, CMC Officials and others. CMC Welfare Camp

CMC conducted a Welfare Camp from March 18 to 31, 2023, for the employees of Out Sourced Agencies to ensure their well-being. Verifying Committees were formed for each Section of CMC, which consisted of three Corporators, In-charge Officer (from a different section), and officials from the same section. The Aadhaar card and EPF/ESI status of each employee was checked, along with their Bank Pass Book transaction for the last four months and salary status. A data base was prepared of 445 employees that include Data Entry Operators, Security Guards, Library Assistants, Gardeners, Sanitation Supervisors and others.



Cleanliness Drive for Ramzan

Cleanliness and hygiene are an intrinsic part of Ramzan. Keeping this in view, CMC initiated a special cleanliness drive around the Mosques of the City, for the holy month of Ramzan. Regular cleaning of surrounding areas twice a day, removal of garbage or debris, desilting of drains, and disinfection of streets with bleaching powder, was being carried out to ensure a clean and safe environment for the worshippers. Apart from that, street lights and drinking water points were checked to ensure its functioning.

Earlier a preparatory meeting for Ramzan was conducted at Biju Bhawan on March 17, 2023 in the presence of Mayor Shri Subhash Chandra Singh and CMC Commissioner, attended by representatives from Muslim Community and concerned officials of CMC. A comprehensive plan for cleanliness, drinking water facility and provision for uninterrupted electricity was discussed.

In order to review and ensure the effective execution of the plan of action, Mayor and CMC Commissioner along with concerned officials visited several Mosques of the City prior to Ramzan.



Holding Tax Camp by Mission Shakti Tax Sathis

Cashless Tax Collection Camps were held in different parts of the City, for the convenience of the citizens to pay their Holding Tax. Citizens can pay tax in the camps held in their respective wards through debit and credit cards, demand drafts, cheques and UPI to concerned Tax Collectors with support from Tax Sathis. The camps were conducted from February 6 to March 31, 2023 covering the entire City on rotation. Total revenue generated during the Holding Tax Camp held from Feb 6 to March 31, 2023 was Rs. 34,048,203/- .



Regular Eviction Drive

To check illegal encroachment, irregularities or violation of rules in hotels, nursing homes, shops and in other places, the CDA & CMC Enforcement department has started 24X7 operation from February, 2023. The decision was taken at a meeting held on Feb 7, 2023 presided by CMC Commissioner Shri Nikhil Pavan Kalyan and attended by CMC Additional Commissioner, CMC Dy. Commissioner Enforcement, CDA Enforcement Officer and other concerned officials. The Enforcement Squad has been regularly conducting eviction drive all over the City in phased manner.



Sankalpa

CMC launched a weekly radio programme 'Sankalpa' on Feb 10, 2023 to create awareness on its various schemes and programmes. Several Talk Shows have been held so far on topics like Food Safety and Trade License, Different Tax collected by CMC and the basis of its calculation, Sanitation projects and the involvement of people, Jaga Mission, Ama Pokhari and many more. On the inaugural show, Commissioner Shri Nikhil Pavan Kalyan spoke about the ongoing developmental works and the upcoming projects. Mayor Shri Subhash Chandra Singh discussed on the plans and programs of CMC.



Promoting SHG Entrepreneurs

Promotion of micro and small-scale enterprises is a crucial strategy for enhancing the economic empowerment of women. To support the Mission Shakti SHG members in their entrepreneurial journey, a seed capital amounting to a total of Rs. 19,74,000, under the Prime Minister Formalisation of Micro Food Enterprise scheme (PMFME) was given to 51 members from 16 Self Help Groups (SHGs), under five Area Level Federations (ALF).

It was given by Mayor Shri Subhash Chandra Singh, in presence of Deputy Mayor, CMC Commissioner and concerned officials at Biju Bhawan on March 19, 2023. PMFME, a landmark initiative under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan, helps in supporting the upgradation of individual micro food processing units.

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Mission Shakti Bazaar

In order to promote and market indigenous products made by SHG members as well as encourage female artisans and craftswomen, a Mission Shakti Bazaar was opened at Cuttack by CMC. It is operated exclusively by SHGs. The Bazaar will provide an excellent platform for SHG members to sell various handicraft, handloom and FMCG products, helping the members strengthen their financial status and managerial ability. It is a step towards empowering women and promoting sustainable livelihoods.



SHG Training Centre

A SHG training centre was set up at Deulasahi to provide handholding support to the Mission Shakti members. Regular orientations and skill development training will be conducted to strengthen their entrepreneurial skill, and keep them updated on the various programs and schemes of H & UD Department.



SHG Members appointed as Jala Sathis

Ten Mission Shakti SHG members have been appointed as Jala Sathis in the last quarter from January to March 2023. They have joined WATCO for collection of Water Cess from general public. This is under the 5T initiative of H&UD department. 61 SHG members have been working as Jal Sathis since 2021. They have been imparted training on consumer handling, water quality testing and POS machine operation.



SHG Members deployed in 5T High Schools

For security and cleaning of 5T High School campuses, 18 Mission Shakti members have been entrusted with the task as Watch and Ward, in the last quarter. The selected SHG members were given orientation by Mission Shakti, CMC and Department of Education on the management of housekeeping and watch & ward services.



24/7 CMC Call Centre

The Call Centre of CMC is part of Mo Sarkar initiative, a feedback-based governance model, where feedback of people is directly received over phone. It is a single point of contact for information related to the various issues of citizens and promote beneficiaries' programs and schemes. It is also a mechanism for monitoring and ensuring the trackability of several activities of CMC. In the first quarter, 47,177 outgoing calls were made by the Call Centre Executives. A total of 7296 calls were received, out of which 2439 were grievance calls and 4857 were inquiry calls.



SCB Swasthya Bikash Samiti General Body Meeting

The General Body Meeting of Swasthya Bikash Samiti, SCBMCH was held on January 21, 2023, to discuss on the developmental activities for providing better health care services. It was chaired by Chairman Swasthya Bikash Samiti and CMC Commissioner Shri Nikhil Pavan Kalyan. Among others present were Shri Bhartruhari Mahatab, MP, Cuttack, Shri Chandra Sarathi Behera, MLA, Cuttack Sadar, Shri Souvik Biswal, MLA, Cuttack-Choudwar, DMET, Dean and Principal, Superintendent and officials of District Administration and SCBMCH.

SCBMCH Help Desk by Mission Shakti SHG

SCB Medical College & Hospital in collaboration with Mission Shakti and CMC has opened four Help Desks in the Hospital campus on March 29, 2023, to provide a single point of contact for people seeking information. The desks, operational from 6am to 10pm are managed by SHG Members known as Swasthya Mitras, in two shifts. Twenty SHG members were given training for two weeks to become Swasthya Mitras.



Kidney Transplantation at SCB A Commendable Achievement

SCBMCH has created history in the world of medical science by successfully transplanting two kidneys in a rare surgery held on March 28, 2023. For the first time the kidney of a patient who died in a private hospital with SCB was brought and transplanted into the body of two patients. The complex surgery of cadaveric kidney transplant was successfully conducted by seventeen medical teams from different departments.



Attendants for Patient Welfare at SCBMCH

To ease the trouble of indoor patients at SCB Medical College and Hospital, bedside investigation services are provided from January 1, 2023. The Sample Collectors collect the samples for routine test from the ward and take it to the lab for testing, following which they deliver the reports to the patients at the bedside. The samples are collected twice a day from wards and ICUs. This has not only helped in alleviating the problems faced by patients and their attendants, but has also reduced rush at the hospital's diagnostic centres.



CAPACITY BUILDING WORKSHOPS

MUKTA

For effective execution of MUKTA projects in the City, CMC conducted a one-day capacity building workshop for Corporators as City Leaders, Community Partners and Urban Local Bodies (ULB) on March 6, 2023. The opening ceremony at Saheed Bhawan was chaired by CMC Deputy Mayor Ms. Damanyanti Majhi, Joint Secretary, H&UD Shri Sarada Prasad Panda and CMC Commissioner. Among others present were CMC Deputy Commissioners, concerned officials, Corporators, as well as SHG and Slum Dwellers Association (SDA) Members.



Urban Waterbody Rejuvenation

An orientation training on Urban Waterbody Rejuvenation was held for ULB officials at Ravenshaw University on March 6, 2023. It was conducted by the Department of Housing and Urban Development, Govt of Odisha in collaboration with National Institute of Urban Affairs (NIUA). The guests present on the occasion were Mayor Shri Subhash Chandra Singh, Shri Sarada Prasad Panda, Joint Secretary H&UDD, Ms. Sagarika Patnaik, Special Secretary H&UDD and Mission Director, AMRUT, CMC Commissioner and Shri Kamaljit Das, Sub Collector & SDM, Cuttack. More than 200 officials took part in the Capacity Building workshop.



Mission Shakti Tax Sathi

To orient the Women Self Help Group on the revenue collection mechanism of CMC, a 3-day training program was held at Biju Bhawan, chaired by CMC Commissioner. It was followed by a 2-day practical demonstration. The selected Tax Sathis of all 59 wards were given training on on-site cashless tax collection by Tax Collectors.



Health and Vaccination Camps



For early diagnosis and treatment, Hepatitis B & C screening was conducted for Sanitary Workers, Swachha Sathis, Waste Handlers and other vulnerable groups at Bikash Bhawan and Saheed Bhawan on March 3 and 4, 2023.

Regular health camps are conducted in various slums under UPHCs for early diagnosis of Tuberculosis (TB) and initiation of treatment. In the 1st quarter 12 health camps were conducted.



Anaemia Mukta Lakhya Abhiyan (AMLAN) programme was started in all Government Schools at Cuttack City on January 2, 2023. In the 1st quarter more than 10,000 students from classes 6 to 12, were screened to identify their anaemic status.

Tetanus and Diphtheria (TD) vaccination was carried out in both Government and Private Schools of Cuttack City. in the month of February and March 2023, 95 percent coverage was achieved.
