1. Invitation for Proposal

Introduction

Cuttack Municipal Corporation (CMC) intends to engage an agency for supplying of Biological inoculant and providing of allied services for stabilization of mixed municipal solid waste. As CMC has planned to establish Mega MRFs of 100 TPD capacity with the installation of modern mechanized equipment & machinery for proper management of dry waste. CMC is currently seeking an innovative approach to effectively manage approximately 300 tonnes per day of mixed municipal solid waste through the formation of windrows. The primary objective is to stabilize the mixed solid waste by deploying timely application of a bio culture. To enhance the efficiency of the process and minimize expenses associated with initial waste segregation using high end equipment, the un-segregated solid waste will undergo a pre-treatment phase to breakdown the degradable portion into a simpler form that can be readily utilized by the bacteria in the bio-culture.

Hence, this EOI is being floated to get techno-commercial offers/ information from interested bidders/agency for the supply of Bio-logical inoculant and providing of allied services for stabilization of mixed municipal solid waste under Cuttack Municipal Corporation.

The contract shall be initially for a **period of 1 (One) years** from the date of signing of Agreement. The contract period may be extended for a further period of one year, subject to satisfactory performance of the Agency/Firm which will be evaluated after completion of the contract.

A "Single Stage" bidding process is planned to be followed for evaluating and determining the successful bidder. The bidders would be required to meet the minimum threshold Technical Qualification Conditions for qualification to undertake the Project as set out in this EOI document. This qualification assessment would be carried out as part of the current bidding and evaluation process. The Financial Proposal of only those bidders that possess the minimum threshold Technical Qualification Conditions and other relevant documents needed for the project would be opened and evaluated.

The EOI document contains information about the Project, bidding process, proposal submission, qualification and financial proposal requirements. All proposals would be evaluated in terms of technical and financial capability of the bidders/agencies.

The EOI submissions must be received latest on 17.08.2024 till 5:00PM in the manner specified in the EOI document at the address given and Cuttack Municipal Corporation shall not be responsible for any delay in receiving the Proposal and reserves the right to reject and/ or accept any or all the Proposals without assigning any reason thereof.

2. General Terms and Conditions / Instructions to Bidders

Technical Eligibility Criteria

- i. The bidder shall be a Manufacturer/authorized representative/distributor/ dealer/retail supplier of bio-culture with proven experience of supplying bio culture to different ULB's of the state or to any sanitation contractors for composting purposes.
- ii. The applicant either directly or through its authorized dealer or distributor within last 03 years should have supplied at least 5000 kg or ltr. of bio inoculants to any urban local bodies/Sanitation Contractor/Solid Waste Management company in India. The bidder shall submit work order or purchase order in support of the claim towards supply of the said materials.
- iii. The bidder must have prior experience of bio-culture application in last 03 or more Legacy/Fresh waste dumpsites available in any Urban Local Bodies of Odisha by engaging its own manpower and resources. In support of the bio-culture application and stabilization of Legacy/Fresh waste dump site the agency shall submit the work order issued by ULBs/ sanitation Contractor/Solid Waste Management company in India.
- iv. The bidder should must have to submit NABL/Ministry of Agriculture /Govt. of India accredited laboratory test certificates of analysis for bio-inoculant.
- v. The bidder should must have submit the brand name/ Make along with the product brochure highlighting the brand name and properties.
- vi. Consortium/Joint Venture are not allowed.
- vii. The agency should have never been Blacklisted or debarred or terminated by any Government Agency in India. A declaration by the bidder in this regard on a duly notarized affidavit is required to be submitted in the format enclosed as Annexure -IV along with EOI proposal.
- viii. Only a duly registered firm can submit bids. The firm shall provide the certificate of registration, along with GST registration number.
- ix. Any bid NOT accompanied by an enforceable and compliant bid security (EMD) may be rejected.

3. Financial Eligibility Criteria

The prospective bidder shall be considered 'financially' eligible if the following criteria are fulfilled:

- i. The bidding Firm/Contractor/Agency shall have minimum average Annual Turnover of Rs. 10 Lakhs during the last three financial years (FY 2020-21 , FY 2021 -22 and FY 2022-23).
- ii. The agency must submit Audited financial statements i.e P/L Account and balance duly audited by the chartered accountant or the Statutory Auditor with valid UDIN details.

a. The bidding firm/Agency shall have the following certificates/registration:

(i) EPF Registration Certificate

(ii) ESI Registration Certificate

(iii) GST Registration

iii. The bidder should have valid PAN in its name.

iv. The bidder should have GST No and should have submitted the last GST return.

4. Terms & Conditions

- i. The Successful agency shall supply the required quantity of Bio-inoculant along with following resources for application of bio-inoculant in approx. **07(Seven) lakh** ton accumulated legacy waste.
 - a. Manpower – 5 -6 nos. with supervisor
 - b. Tanks – (Minimum 5000 ltr. capacity -02 nos.)
 - c. Spraying machine as per requirement
- ii. The rates will be quoted price per Kg. which will include the cost of manpower, material as well as the transportation cost. CMC will not support or entertain any associated cost for the treatment of waste except the charge for per unit Kg of Bio-inoculants.
- iii. The per kg or ltr cost of Bio-inoculants to be quoted by the agency shall include the cost of adequate resources including manpower as mentioned above in the clause.
- iv. The agency along with the supply of the Bio-inoculants shall ensure its stabilization by engagement of its manpower and resources as per requirement.
- v. The ceiling price towards supply of 01 Kg or 01 Ltr. biological inoculants including the resources as mentioned in clause no-i is Rs 150 excluding applicable GST.
- vi. The authority depending upon the requirement shall directly request the empanelled agencies through mail/letter for submission of quotation within a period of three (03) days of receiving the mail/letter.
- vii. The empanelled agencies shall submit their quotations through mail within the due date and time to the concerned official.
- viii. The quotations submitted by the empanelled agencies shall not be beyond the ceiling price as proposed.
- ix. The lowest quotations submitted by the empanelled agency shall be considered for issue of work order.
- x. The empanelled agency shall deliver the materials and engage the required resources within a period of 15 days of receiving of LOA or purchase order and ensure application of Bio-inoculants.
- xi. The delivery of biological inoculants shall be made F.O.R site.
- xii. The supply schedule shall be as per the agreed-upon delivery dates specified by Cuttack Municipal Corporation.
- xiii. The Supplier ensure that the products are delivered on time and ensure its application through engagement of different resources.

5. Product Quality and Compliance:

- i. The supplied biological Inoculant must meet the specified technical specifications and standards outlined in the contract.
- ii. The products must be of high quality, free from defects, and suitable for the intended purpose.
- iii. The supplier shall ensure that the products comply with all applicable regulations, standards, and safety requirements.

6. Consideration for supply of Bio-culture

The supplier shall propose the Bio-culture keeping in view the following requirements:

- i. Increase beneficial Microbial activity.
- ii. Effectively degrade waste in less time.
- iii. Reduce odour from the waste pile.
- iv. Converts organic waste into high quality compost that doubles up as excellent soil conditioner.
- v. Effective under most environment conditions.
- vi. Easy to use, handle and store.
- vii. Compatible for Composting Machines also.

7. Packaging and Labeling:

- i. The supplier shall package the products appropriately to ensure their safety and integrity during transportation and storage.
- ii. Each package should be properly labeled with product information, batch numbers, manufacturing dates, expiry dates (if applicable), and any other relevant details as required by regulations.

8. Delivery and Transportation:

- i. The supplier shall be responsible for the safe and timely delivery of the products to the designated locations within the territorial jurisdiction of Cuttack Municipal Corporation.
- ii. The supplier shall bear all costs and risks associated with transportation, including loading unloading, insurance, and any necessary permits or licenses.

9. Inspection and Acceptance:

- i. Cuttack Municipal Corporation reserves the right to inspect and test the supplied products to ensure compliance with the specified requirements.
- ii. The products will undergo a thorough inspection upon delivery, and acceptance shall be based on meeting the specified quality and technical standards.

10. Payment Terms:

- i. Payments shall be made based on satisfactory delivery and application of bio-culture in Legacy/Accumulated waste site at TTS as per the agreed terms.
- ii. Invoices submitted by the supplier must be accurate, complete, and supported by appropriate documentation.

11. Period of Contract

1. Contract Duration:

- i. The empanelment shall be in effect for a period of 1 year from the date of signing of agreement.
- ii. The supplier shall adhere to the terms and conditions outlined in the contract during the period of empanelment.

2. Renewal or Extension:

- i. The contract may be renewed or extended beyond the initial 1-year period upon mutual agreement between Cuttack Municipal Corporation and the supplier.
- ii. Any renewal or extension shall be documented through a written agreement specifying the revised terms and conditions, including the duration, pricing, and other relevant provisions.

3. Termination:

- i. Either party may terminate the contract before its expiration in case of a material breach of contractual obligations by the other party.
- ii. Termination may also occur if either party becomes insolvent, bankrupt, or undergoes a change in ownership or control.

- iii. The terminating party shall provide a written notice of termination, specifying the reasons for termination and the effective date of termination.

4. Change of Terms:

- i. Any changes or modifications to the terms and conditions of the contract shall be made in writing and require mutual agreement between Cuttack Municipal Corporation and the supplier.
- ii. Changes may include alterations in quantity, delivery schedule, pricing, or any other relevant provisions.
- iii. Both parties shall document any changes to the contract through an amendment or a formal agreement

12. Failing in supply by the buyer

In case of any default in supplying the materials by the buyer(s) within the time limits as specified in clause 5.1, Cuttack Municipal Corporation will impose a penalty of 5% sales order value per week and non-supplying of waste more than one month the Security Deposit (as the case may be) will automatically stand forfeited and in addition, Cuttack Municipal Corporation has right to terminate the Contract.

13. Termination/breach of contract

In case of breach of any of terms and conditions mentioned above, the Commissioner, CMC, Cuttack will have the right to cancel the work order without assigning any reason thereof, and nothing will be payable by the Commissioner, CMC in that event and the security deposit in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee shall be encased /forfeited. The decision of Commissioner, CMC in this regard shall be final and binding on the contractor.

14. Arbitration:

In case of any dispute arising out of or connected with or incidental to this contract. The dispute will be referred to an arbitrator appointed by the Commissioner CMC, Cuttack. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties. The arbitration proceedings will be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration and Reconciliation Act, 1996.

15. Insurance:

The Insurance cover protecting the agency against all claims applicable under the Workman's Compensation Act 1948 shall be taken by the Agency/Firm. The Agency/Firm shall arrange necessary insurance cover for any claim arising out of mishap, if any that may take place. In the event of any liability/claim falling on CMC, the same shall be reimbursed/indemnified by the Agency/Firm.

16. Single Bidder:

CMC will do its best to encourage the participation of multiple parties for the tender, however in the case of a single bidder, CMC can take a decision of awarding the contract due to the nature of the service being that of emergency services and affecting the lives of the citizens of the city.

17. Force Majeure:

If at any time during the currency of the contract, either party is subject to force majeure, which can be termed as civil disturbance, riots, strikes, tempest, acts of God etc., may prevent either party to discharge his obligation, the affected party shall promptly notify the other party about the happening of such an event. Neither party shall be reason of such event to be entitled to terminate the contract in respect of such performance of their obligations. The obligations under the contract shall be resumes as soon as practicable after the event has come to an end or ceased to exist. The performance of any obligations

under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after the event has come to an end or ceased to exist. If the performance of any obligation under the contract is prevented or delayed by reason of the event beyond a period mutually agreed to if any or seven days, whichever is more, either party may at its option terminate the contract.

18. Any other Additional Information relevant to the proposal

a. Preparation of Proposals

- i. The Proposal as well as all related correspondence exchanged by the agencies and the Employer, shall be written in English language.
- ii. In preparing their Proposal, Agencies are expected to examine in detail the documents comprising the EOI. Material deficiencies in providing the information requested may result in the rejection of a Proposal.
- iii. While preparing the Technical Proposal, Agencies must give particular attention to the following:
- iv. Depending on the nature of the Assignment/ job, Agencies are required to submit a Technical Proposal (TP) in forms provided In the EOI. Submission of the wrong type of Technical Proposal will result in the Proposal being deemed non-responsive.
- v. A brief description of the Agency's, organization will provide details of the experience of assignments that are similar to the proposed assignment/ job as per the terms of reference.
- vi. Agencies should be prepared to substantiate the claimed experience along with the proposal and must submit letter of award/ copy of the contract for all the assignments mentioned in the proposal. A description of the approach, methodology, and work plan for performing the Assignment/ job covering the following subjects.
